The Fall of the Ancestral Pueblo

For 600 years the Ancestral Pueblo enjoyed a rich and powerful civilization. However, by 1300 their cities were vacant, and their trading empire had collapsed. There are many ideas about what brought about the end of their civilization. These include drought, wars, disease, and competition among their communities. After leaving their cities, the Ancestral Pueblo settled in other parts of the Southwest. Their descendants are today's Hopi, Zuni, and other Pueblo peoples.

Some Pueblo peoples continue to live in pueblos of the Ancestral style. Acoma Pueblo, thought to be more than 900 years old, is the oldest occupied town in the United States.



Problem Solving 🚥

The first Native Americans faced new problems when they settled in new regions. The Ancestral Pueblo, for example, settled in the dry Southwest. Without enough rain, they could not grow their crops. How could they solve this problem?

Learn It

- Identify the problem. For the Ancestral Pueblo, the problem was too little water for farming. During the driest summers, crops died, and people faced starvation.
- Gather information. The Ancestral Pueblo knew that some of their lands had more water than others. They also knew they could bring water from rivers to their fields.
- Identify the choices. The Ancestral Pueblo had options or choices. They could move to a region with more rainfall. They could find ways to water their fields.
- Think about the options. Every choice, or option, has a consequence, or outcome. The Ancestral Pueblo might have been attacked if they moved to new territories. Digging channels to move water to new areas would be difficult.
- Think about the best solution. The Ancestral Pueblo had to evaluate, or judge, each solution. They decided to irrigate their fields. Of all the solutions, this seemed the safest and best choice.
